

Sardis Lake Christian Camp – Session 1

Transportation: Vans will leave the church parking lot at 12:30 so eat lunch and return in time to load your luggage. Parents are welcome to take their children to camp if they wish. If you do take your children to camp in your own vehicle but want them to return in a church van, please notify Paul Bennett BEFORE Sunday so we can make sure we have enough room to bring them back. If you plan to pick them up, they must be off campus by 10 a.m. Saturday.

Dress Code: Shorts must be close to the knee. No tank tops, spaghetti straps, low cut tops or mini skirts. No revealing clothing. Girls' swimsuit cover-ups must also meet the dress code for walking to/from the pool.

Younger children: It would be helpful if one full change of clothes was placed in a gallon Ziploc for each day. Please make sure all items are labeled with the child's name.

Cabins 1 and 2 are for the younger campers and are equipped with a bathroom and electrical outlets. Boy's cabins 3-7 and Girl's cabin 3 do not have outlets or bathrooms but they do have access to a girl's bathhouse/boy's bathhouse which do have outlets. Girl's cabins 4-7 are the new cabins.

A SLCC 2015 t-shirt will be provided to all campers. (Counselors and staff must pay for their own.)

All forms of medication must be given to the nurse upon arrival and will be administered by her. NO medication of any kind can be in the cabins.

We will have a talent show on Thursday & all campers are welcome to enter. We also have our cabin skits on Friday night. All parents are welcome to attend. It's always a great ending to the week.
